



Founded in 1829 by King George IV and the Duke of Wellington, King's College London is the fourth oldest university in England.

Situated in the centre of London, classes take place in the Virginia Woolf building, while accommodation is located in fully-furnished apartments, a ten minute walk over Waterloo Bridge in Conway Hall (part of Notre Dame University).

King's College London's central location provides ample opportunities for students to visit a variety of landmarks and attractions, with famous sites such as St Paul's Cathedral, Oxford Street and Piccadilly Circus all less than a mile away.

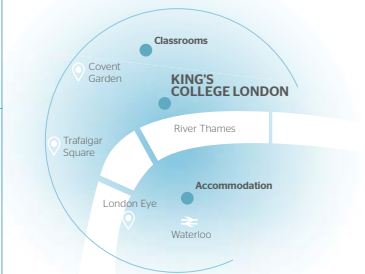
